Icon of the Mechanical Industry Louis Boone, Boone & Darr Passes

Louie Boone, co-founder of Boone & Darr, Inc, died from a stroke on January 19th, 2015. The company had just celebrated it's 60th year in business.

Louie was also a founding member of our Association and an active and dedicated member until his retirement in 1984. He was President and held all officer positions. He served on numerous Boards and Committees throughout the years, including being on the Michigan Plumbing Contractors Board of Directors.

He was an accomplished equestrian and an avid sportsman. His greatest joy was being with family and friends.

Before becoming a contractor Louie was a member of UA Local 190 where he received his technical training. In accordance with Louie's wishes, his body has been donated for U of M medical research and there was no funeral or memorial service.



Louie was a student in the first apprenticeship program with UA Local 190 and the Washtenaw County Plumbing Contractors Association commencing in 1946. The class received special recognition at UA 190's September 2004 Awards banquet.

Louis Boone Receives First W. Nelson Vander Hyden Memorial Award

Louis Boone, Past President and Director of the PMC Association was presented the first annual W. Nelson Vander Hyden Memorial Award at the annual meeting of the Washtenaw Contractors Association.

Louie, President of Boone & Darr, Inc., was chosen to receive the honor by the Board of Directors of the WCA.



W. Nelson Vander Hyden died this past year of cancer at the age of 54. He had been President of Jeffress-Dyer Construction Company since 1964, and came to the community with the company in 1956, during a time when that firm built numerous local buildings including the U of M's Children's Hospital, Institute for Social Research, University Hospital Outpatient Building, Phoenix Memorial Laboratory and Kresge Medical Research Facility to mention just a few. U of M Director of Physical Property, Jack Weidenbach, called Vander Hyden "always a gentleman and professional" as he spoke to the contractors prior to the presentation of the award. Local architect Don Wright called Vander Hyden 'a contractor's contractor', as he told of the background of the award. "This award will be presented annually to the individual or firm who have used the high standards of professionalism that characterized Van and contributed to the betterment or improvement of the construction industry."

The award was presented by Paul Rose, current President of Jeffress-Dyer who noted that Boone was a close friend of the late contractor and has displayed many of the ideals and professional qualities which everyone saw in Vander Hyden. Anne Vander Hyden, the late contractor's wife, assisted in the presentation and called Boone a true friend. "You can count the number of people who are willing to give their life for you on the fingers of one hand and Louie is one of them," she said. "CONGRATULATIONS LOUIE!

Louie passed away early in the morning of January 15, 2015.



degrees accomplished. The ripple is endless and unmeasureable.


