Each year MPMCA honors a local association of the year --- not only for its activities that serve their membership, but also for the value that these local associations add to their communities, their support of our industry, and for their support of the Michigan Plumbing & Mechanical Contractors Association.

This past year the organization built its 45th home -- a feat unmatched in the country. Also, the PMC and their UA partners have completed 25 consecutive - Heat's On Projects in the local Michigan area.

This was the 15<sup>th</sup> year the project has been done in the Big Rapids area, where the PMC's student chapter exists. This gives them 40 programs in the last 25 years.

The volunteer programs PMC are involved include, but are not limited to: Viet Nam Memorial - The Moving Wall; Toys for Tots, Food Gathers, Packets for Soldiers, Muscular Dystrophy Lock-Up, School for the Performing Arts, co-sponsors the UA Annual 5k Pub Crawl to benefit the injured Marine Semper Fi Fund, along with numerous local charities.

Career involvement include: a construction career website: misconstructioncareers.org with a career manual that is distributed at career programs, sponsoring programs for children, Dr. Katz at the local Learning Fair doing HVACR related experiments, and more.

For 30 years, PMC has sponsored an Inspectors luncheon with all local inspectors and representatives from the Michigan licensing Board and Construction Code Commission. Heralded by the participants as the only one in the country, it gives the contractors and inspectors the opportunity to become better acquainted and work better together.
